

This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by **Rebecca Revich**, an individual researcher associated with the Arizona State University College of Law, for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States. **Ms. Revich** is a second year law student at the Arizona State University College of Law who is preparing a substantial research paper involving empirical research on bankruptcy issues.

The Court finds that **Rebecca Revich**, as an individual researcher, has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, **Rebecca Revich** shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of her research. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- 1. this fee exemption applies only to **Rebecca Revich** and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
