General Order # M-429

WHEREAS, this Court, by means of **General Order M-363** (signed December 9, 2008), adopted Interim Rule 1007-I, which implements the 2008 amendments to 11 U.S.C. § 707(b) providing a temporary exclusion from the application of the means test for certain members of the National Guard and Reserves;

WHEREAS, this Court, by means of **General Order M-391** (signed December 28, 2009), adopted the amended version of Interim Rule 1007-I, as amended by the Judicial Conference of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, on December 13, 2011, signed into law the National Guard and Debt Relief Extension Act of 2011, which extended – for four additional years (until December 18, 2015) – the temporary exclusion from the application of the means test for certain members of the National Guard and Reserves; it is, therefore,

ORDERED that the applicability of Interim Rule 1007-I to cases filed in this district is extended for so long as such exclusion from the means test remains operative under federal law.
